

JOINT STUDY PROGRAM IN FOOD ENGINEERING – FIRST EDITION

University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn (Poland) and
University of Applied Sciences in Offenburg (Germany)



In spring semester 2016, the University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn and the University of Applied Sciences in Offenburg offered, for the first time, a joint Master's degree program in food engineering.

The first semester has just finished. Nine Polish students and three students from Offenburg took courses in Food Physics and Rheology; Technological Equipment in Food Processing; Food Marketing and Production Economics; Food Quality and Safety Management; Novel Food Products; Enzymology, Bioinformatics and Bioprocesses; Technical Microbiology; English Terminology in Food Engineering; Methodology of Experimental Studies; Basics of Nutrition; Physical Education. Now the Polish students are preparing themselves for the second semester, which will focus on process engineering and will be based at Offenburg University.

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
